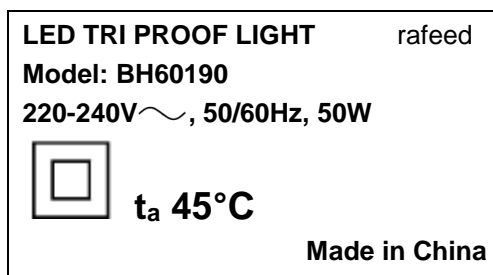

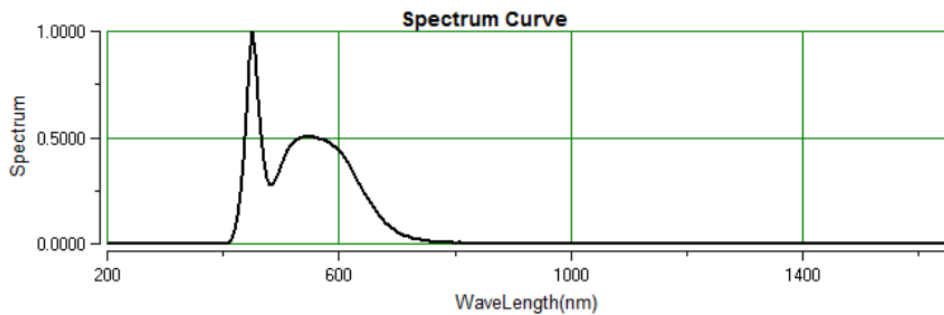

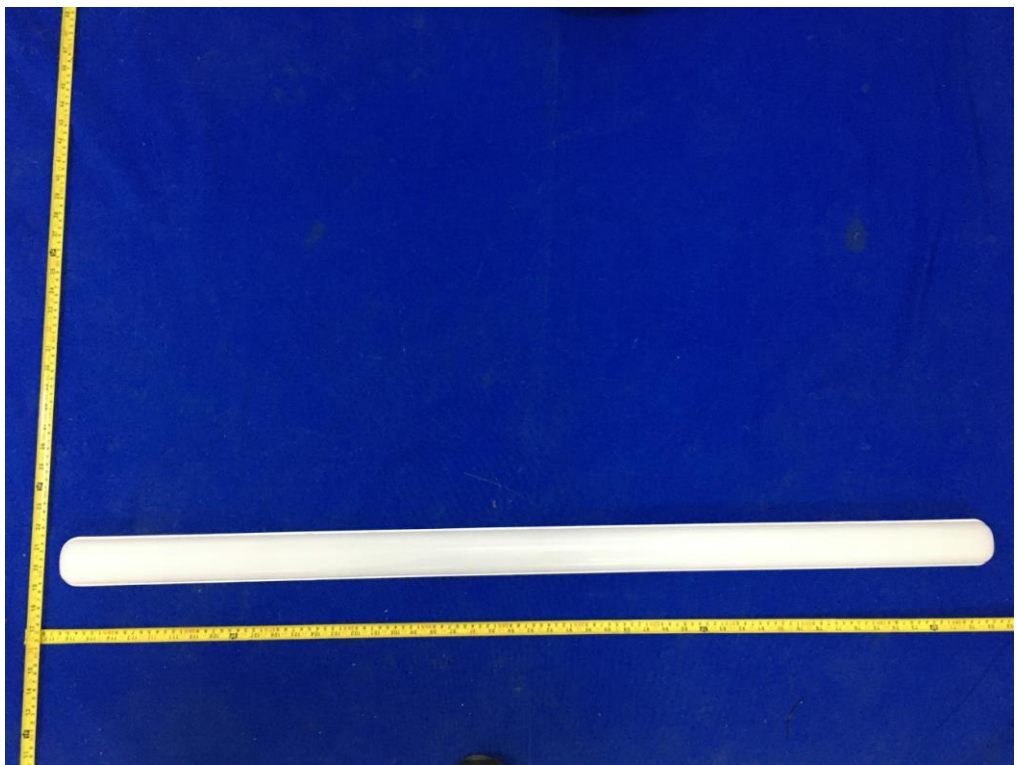


Figure 1. Overview of model BH60190

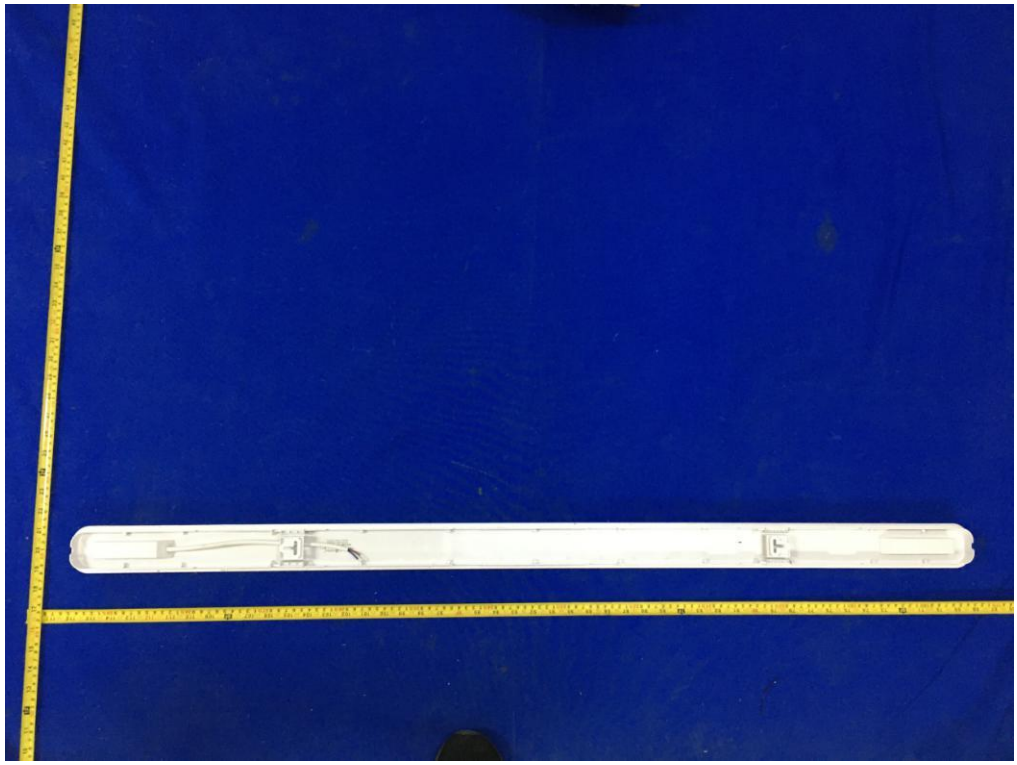


Figure 2. Overview of model BH60190

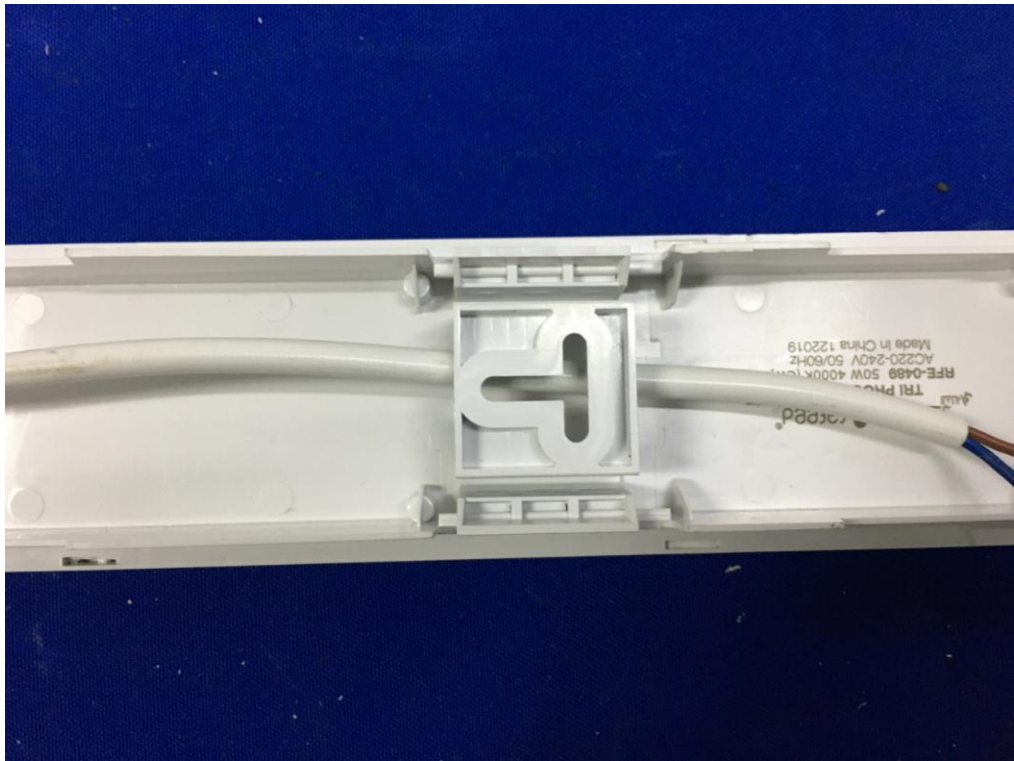


Figure 3. Over view of model BH60190

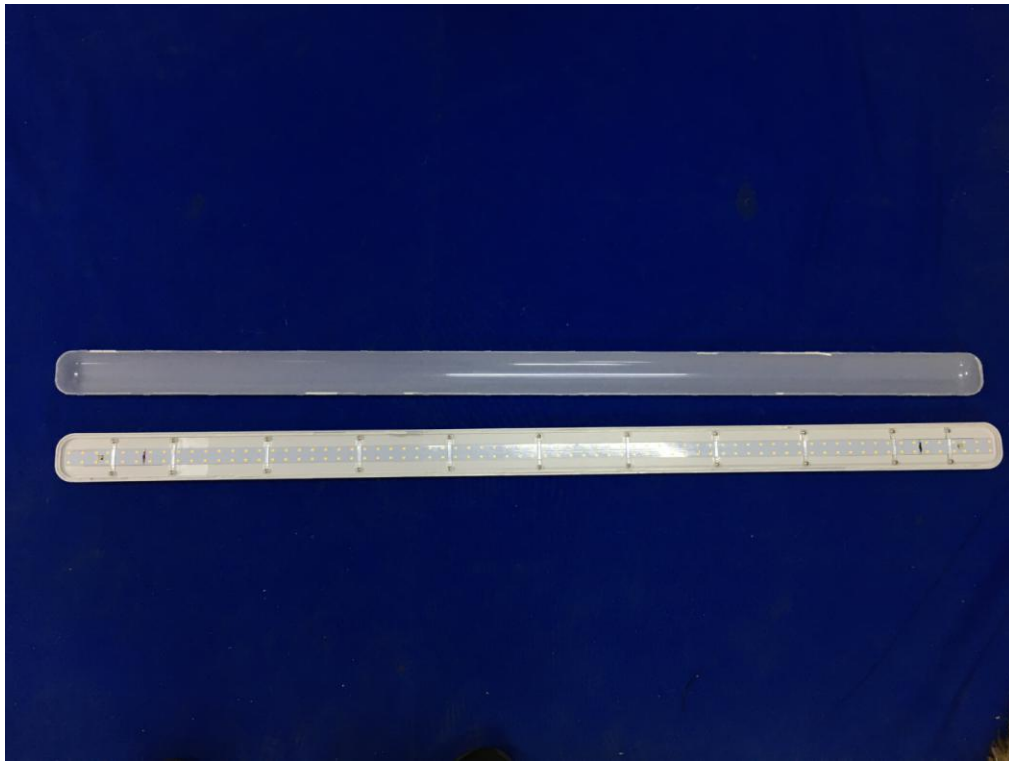


Figure 5. Internal view of model BH60190

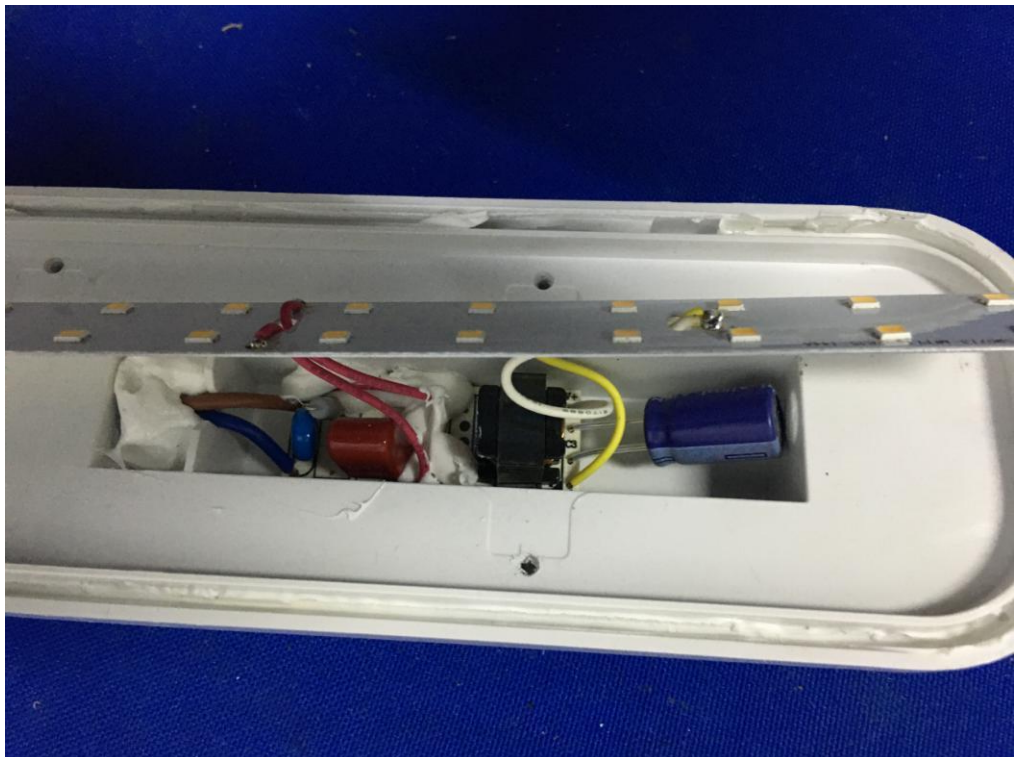


Figure 8. Internal view of model BH60190

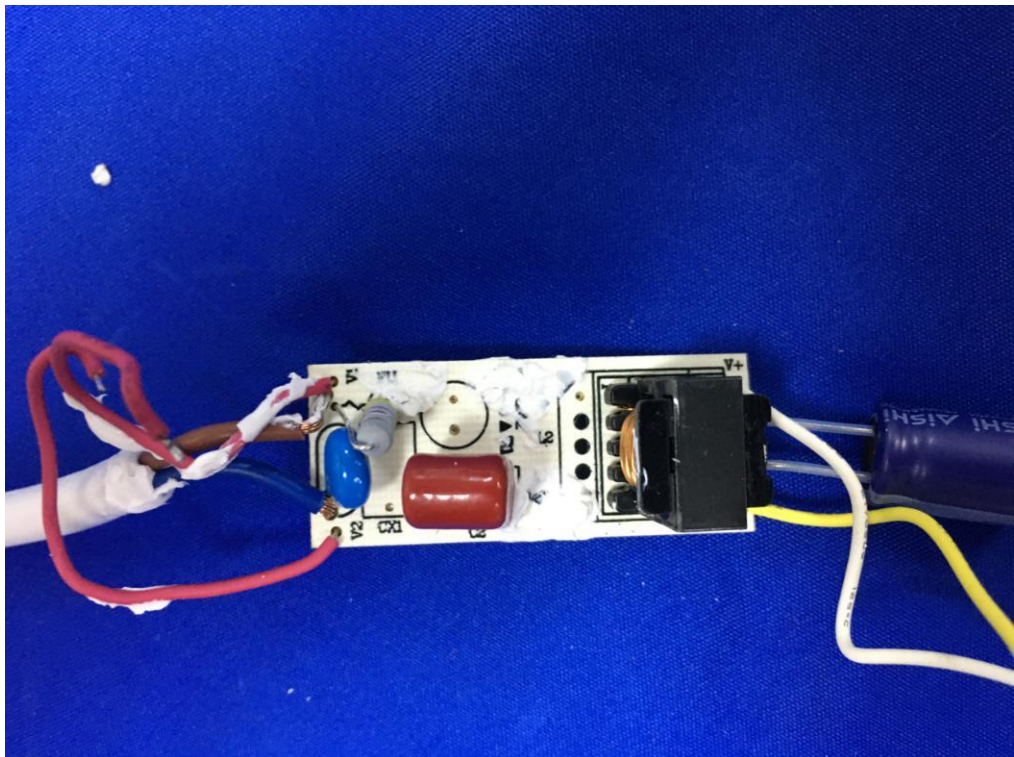


Figure 10. PCB view of model BH60190

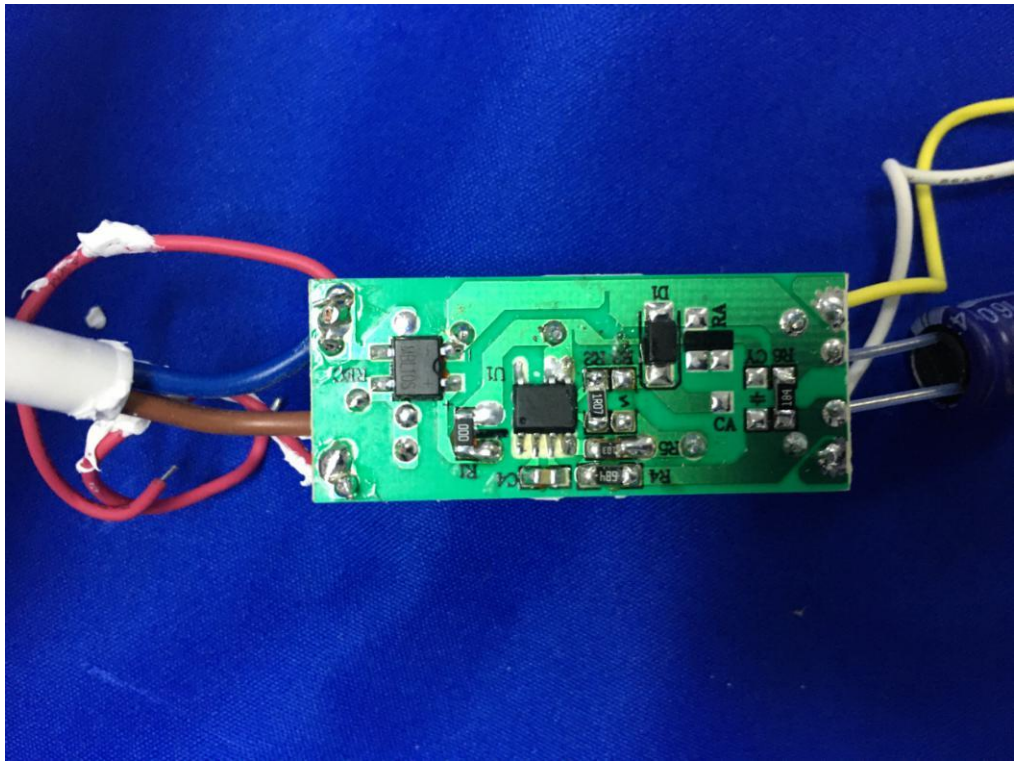


Figure 11. PCB view of model BH60190

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
